Hanoi - Halong Bay - Hanoi

Day 1: Hanoi - Halong Bay (-, L, D)

Pick up at your hotel in Hanoi for a morning drive to Halong. Day 1: Ho Chi Minh City - Can Tho - Tra On - Mang Thit (B, L, D)

Pick up at your hotel in downtown Ho Chi Minh City and drive to Can Tho. Embark the BASSAC and perform the cabin check-in with welcome drink and introduction to the ship and crew. Depart cruising downstream of the Hau River with lunch served on board while en route. After touring near Tra On floating market, continue cruising on Mang Thit River, a branch of Hau River, towards Co Chien River. Relax on the upper deck or enjoy the open bar viewing the beautiful scenery of rice fields, sugar cane, woods on the near banks. Stop for visiting a village on the banks of Mang Thit River, an opportunity to appreciate the way of life and hospitality of the local inhabitants, and the orchard or rice fields nearby. Day 2: Cai Be - Ho Chi Minh City (B, -, -)

Arrive in Cai Be, check-out and board a local boat for a tour of Cai Be floating market and handicraft. Pick up at Cai Be and drive back to Ho Chi Minh City. Drop off at your hotel.
