HUEMT 09.07 Hue garden houses (half day)

Hue owes its beauty not only to the Perfume River, Mount Ngu Binh and royal mausoleums but also to garden houses. As a prominent trait of Hue, they are relaxing spaces featuring all kinds of fruit trees and flowers and cover an area of about 2,000 square meters each. All shows the love of nature of the owners, one of Hue people's characteristics. The trip takes visitors to 2 distinctive garden houses, where all guests are welcomed as members of the families. Optional with surcharge: A Hue expert with wide knowledge of Hue culture can be arranged to escort visitors.

HUEMT 09.08 Hue - Danang - Hoi An (2D/ 1N Program)

Day 1: Hue - Danang - Hoi An (B, -, -)
In the morning pick up at your hotel and leave Hue by road for Danang via the 6,280-metre-long Hai Van Tunnel, the longest highway tunnel in Southeast Asia. On arrival in Danang, visit the Museum of Cham Sculpture (closed on Monday) with the World's finest collection of some 300 Cham sculpture exhibits dating from the 7th to the 15th centuries, the Marble Mountains (or Ngu Hanh Son) of the five sacred elements (metal, wood, water, fire and soil) with numerous caves and Buddhist shrines, and the stone-carving village of Non Nuoc. Then proceed to Hoi An ancient town, a major Asian trading port in the 17th and 18th centuries. Relax at one of the most beautiful beaches of Vietnam and enjoy the hotel/resort facilities or rest of the day. Stay overnight in Hoi An.

Day 2: Hoi An & Departure (B, -, -)
Morning have a walking tour of the ancient town centre. Stroll around the Japanese and Chinese Quarters to visit a number of temples, pagodas, communal houses, traditional shops, local markets and other places of interest and watch local daily activities, handicraftsmen at work and a lively show of traditional dancing and music. Afternoon drive to Danang airport or Danang train station for departure. End of service.

HUEMT 09.09 Hue - Danang - Hoi An (3D/ 2N Program)

Day 1: Hue - Danang (B, -, -)
In the morning pick up at your hotel and leave Hue by road for Danang via the Pass of Ocean Clouds and the scenic fishing village of Lang Co. Enjoy the beautiful landscapes and panoramic views of the clouds, the sea and the mountains during the journey. On arrival in Danang, visit five sacred hills known as the Marble Mountains with numerous caves and Buddhist shrines, the stone-carving village of Non Nuoc, and the Museum of Cham Sculpture (closed on Monday) with the World's finest collection of some 300 Cham sculpture exhibits dating from the 7th to the 15th centuries. Rest of the day relax at one of the most beautiful beaches of Vietnam and enjoy the hotel/resort facilities, or discover the city on your own. Stay overnight in Danang.

Vinh Moc Tunnels - Quang Tri

Day 2: Danang - Hoi An (B, -, -)
In the morning, transfer to Hoi An. Have a walking tour of the ancient town centre. Stroll around the Japanese and Chinese Quarters to visit a number of temples, pagodas, communal houses, traditional shops, local markets and other places of interest and watch local daily activities, handicraftsmen at work and a lively show of traditional dancing and music. Afternoon relax on the beach or enjoy hotel facilities. Stay overnight in Hoi An.

Day 3: Departure from Danang (B, -, -)
Spend last minutes shopping before check-out. Transfer to the airport or Danang train station for departure. End of service.

HUEMT 09.10 DMZ and Ho Chi Minh Trail (day tour)

Pick up at your hotel in downtown Hue and start the trip to the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ), which was established in 1954 by the Geneva Peace Accord and became fiercest battlefields during the Vietnam War from 1954 to 1975. Then take a return trip to Hue on Route 14 which once formed part of the Ho Chi Minh Trail. The tour highlights include the old Quang Tri citadel, Hien Luong Bridge spanning the Ben Hai River, the Vinh Moc Tunnels, the Ho Chi Minh Trail, Ben Tat Bridge, Truong Son Cemetery, and Dakrong Bridge. Return to Hue and drop off at your hotel. End of service.

HUEMT 09.11 DMZ & Phong Nha Cavern (2D/ 1N Program)

Day 1: Hue - DMZ - Dong Hoi (B, -, -)
Pick up at your hotel in Hue and drive for Quang Tri town, where you can see some war remnants and the original ramparts and gates of former Quang Tri Citadel. Stop over at Ben Hai River, formerly known as a demarcation line between the North and the South of Vietnam. Then proceed to Vinh Moc with the amazing 2.8 km of underground tunnels, dug to accommodate an underground village safe from American air raids in the north of the DMZ. Continue driving through the sites of the former fierce battle fields of Dong Ha, Doc Mieu and Vinh Linh before arriving in Dong Hoi. Stay overnight in Dong Hoi.

Day 2: Dong Hoi - Phong Nha - Hue (B, -, -)
Before leaving for Phong Nha, wander about the Nhat Le Fish Market, with sellers and buyers invariably wearing the ubiquitous conical hat. Transfer to the Xuan Son river wharf (45km) and take a boat trip on the Son River to spectacular Phong Nha Cavern, formed about 250 million years ago and recognized as World Natural Heritage site. Climb about 400 steps to splendid Tien Son Cave (1km), the most magnificent limestone cave in Vietnam and just opened in 2000. Travel southwards to Hue (220km) along the Truong Son Road (former Ho Chi Minh trail). Some war vestiges can be visited en route to include Ben Tat Bridge, Truong Son Cemetery, etc. On returning to Hue, drop off at your hotel. End of service.
