DADMT 09.01

Basic Tour (3D/2N Program)

Services comprise one-way guided transfer from or to Danang Airport/ Danang train station and two-night accommodation in Danang or Hoi An. Please refer to the following modules and choose some of them to add on to the Basic Tour and create your own package.

Day 1: Arrival in Danang /- Hoi An (-, -, -)
Arrive at Danang airport or Danang train station. Meet & transfer to hotel in Danang or Hoi An. Add-on tour if time permits. Stay overnight in Danang or Hoi An.

Day 2: Tour at your choice (B, -, -)
Add-on tour or modular tour is at your choice. Stay overnight in Danang or Hoi An.

Day 3: Tour at your choice or Departure from Danang or Hoi An (B, -, -)
Optionally extend your stay with modular tour or request Danang or Hoi An departure transfer.

Danang or Hoi An Departure Transfer

Meet at your hotel in Danang or Hoi An and transfer to Danang airport or Danang train station for departure, or transfer by road to Hue.

DADMT 09.03

Danang city tour (half day)

Danang is a city of contrasts, sparking seaside beauty and spectacular mountain scenery. Rich in history, it has been the centre of many different cultures over the centuries. A half day city tour in Danang features the Marble Mountains (or Ngu Hanh Son), the Non Nuoc carving village, the Cham Museum and a pedicab ride (1 hour) along the Han River to shopping centers. Visitors will find local markets good not only for shopping but also for snapshots. Pick up and drop off at your hotel in Danang or Hoi An, or add this tour on to the basic program or Hue-Danang/Hoi An overland transfer.

Hoi An ancient town (half day)

Hoi An ancient town was declared a World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO in late 1999. This World Heritage site combines Chinese, Japanese, European and Vietnamese influences and boasts a delightful mixture of ancient structures with the local residents' modern life. It creates a unique image of a modern-day town in the atmosphere of bygone days. Enjoy a walking tour of the enchanting port town of Hoi An to visit the ancient structures comprising the 400 year-old Japanese Covered Bridge, residential houses, assembly halls, historic and ancient pagodas, etc., the colorful market, shops offering silk lanterns, paintings and high quality clothes; and watch local daily activities, handicraftsmen at work and a lively show of traditional dancing & music. Pick up and drop off at your hotel in Danang or Hoi An.

Da Nang & Hoi An ancient town (day tour)

In the morning visit five sacred hills known as the Marble Mountains with numerous caves and Buddhist shrines, the stone-carving village of Non Nuoc and the Museum of Cham Sculpture (closed on Monday) with the World's finest collection of some 300 Cham sculpture exhibits dating from the 7th to the 15th centuries. Then have a pedicab ride (1 hour) along the Han River to shopping centers. In the afternoon enjoy a walking tour of the enchanting port town of Hoi An to visit the ancient structures comprising the 400 year-old Japanese Covered Bridge, residential houses, assembly halls, historic and ancient pagodas, etc., the colorful market, shops offering silk lanterns, paintings and high quality clothes; and watch local daily activities, handicraftsmen at work and a lively show of traditional dancing & music. Pick up and drop off at your hotel in Danang or Hoi An.

My Son & Hoi An (day tour)

Enjoy a whole day to explore two World Cultural Heritage sites declared by UNESCO in 1999. Depart a scenic drive for My Son Sanctuary, located in a lush green valley, where the architectural treasures and sculptures of Cham culture dating from the 7th to the 13th century can be discovered. Then travel 55 km on rural roads to Hoi An ancient town. Stop en route to visit Tra Kieu, formerly known as the Lion Citadel, the capital of Champa between the 4th and 8th centuries. On arrival in Hoi An, a major Asian trading port in the 17th and 18th centuries, have a walking tour of the ancient town centre. Stroll around the Japanese and Chinese Quarters to visit a number of temples, pagodas, communal houses, traditional shops, local markets and other places of interest and watch local daily activities, handicraftsmen at work and a lively show of traditional dancing and music. Pick up and drop off at your hotel in Danang or Hoi An.

Hoi An daily routine tour (half day)

It is a leisurely stroll to the surrounding countryside of Hoi An where you can take part in or just watch the local daily routines. First enjoy a bike ride (2km) to the Thanh Nam fishing village, where the riverine life of the locals on the Thu Bon River can be seen. Visitors can try casting fish nets, etc. Then, take a boat ride back to Hoi An. Lunch and a cooking practice session of Hoi An specialties are arranged at a local home. Pick up and drop off at your hotel in Danang or Hoi An.
